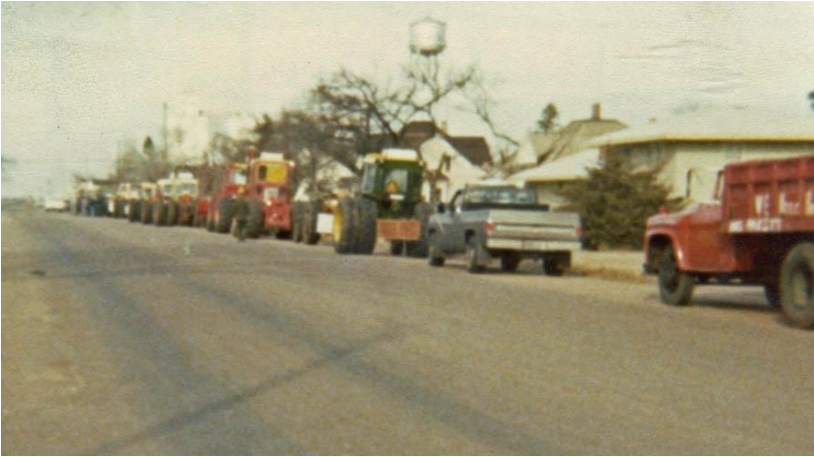

Diane & Clara Stapleton washing pickup to go to Topeka with tractors. Jeff drove Stapleton's 7040 Allis-Chalmers.



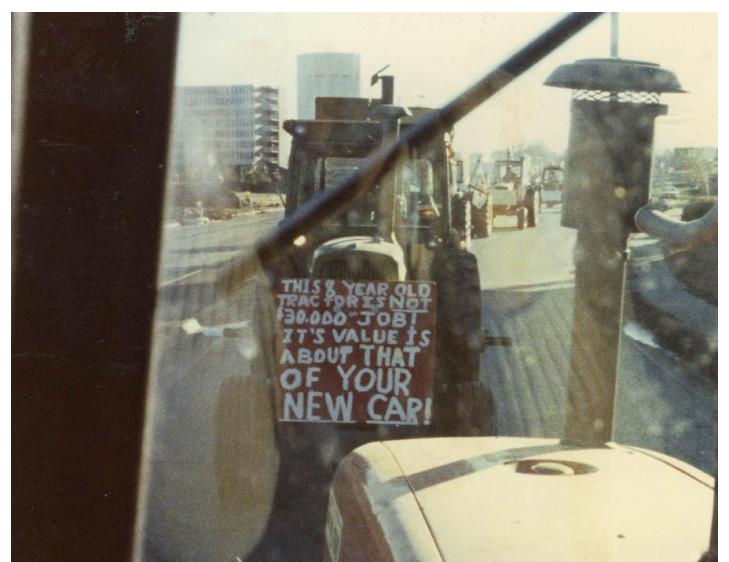

Tractors from all over the state of Kansas parked in Shawnee County fairgrounds, waiting to parade the next morning in Topeka, December 15, 1978.



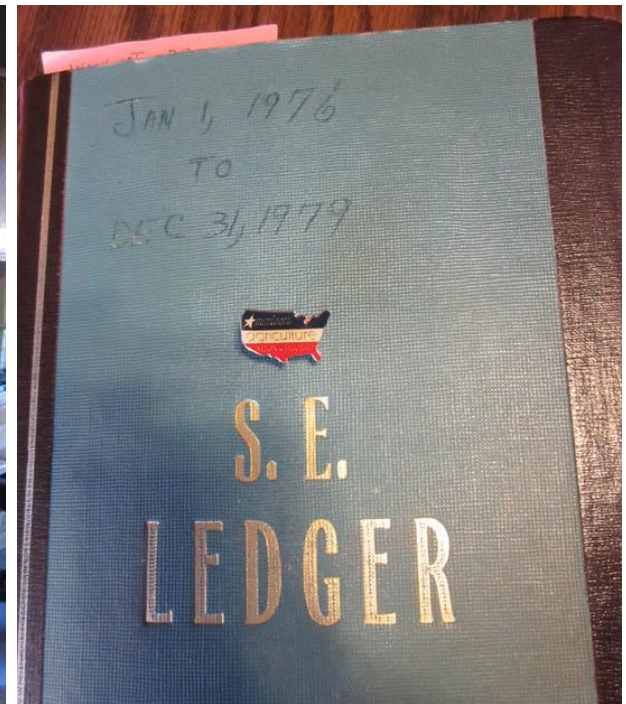
